The meeting started with the general remarks of the Registrar. The Registrar pointed out that there is no clarity in the seat matrix of almost all M.Tech courses. Some departments fill their sponsored seats from the sanctioned seats and the present seat matrix has to be revised in accordance with the sanctioned seats. Based on the detailed discussions, the meeting recommended the following;

1. Seat matrix may be prepared on the basis of total approved seats excluding supernumerary seats. Special reservation seats shall not be included in the regular seats.
2. All supernumerary seats may be **over and above** the AICTE approved intake.
3. **Two** supernumerary seats may be sanctioned for sponsored students for all M.Tech Courses.
4. Steps may be taken for getting the approval of the Syndicate for fixing the number of seats of M.Tech in tune with the approved intake of AICTE.
5. In case of M.Tech courses without AICTE approval, the sanctioned intake by the Syndicate may be continued.
